Duty to God Award



The Sea Base “Duty to God” program is designed to expand a participant’s awareness of this bountiful creation, our responsibility to the land, air and sea. Also to examine our relationship to our Creator – God.

This award program was put together to help stimulate the religious journey of both scouts and scouters as they spend their time at Sea Base. It is designed to tie together the chaplaincy services at Sea Base, and the scouting program at large as well as the scouts own feelings and views on his or her religious practices.

Both adults and youth participants of Sea Base may take part in this program.

Participants need to complete requirements 1 and 2, as well as two of the remaining three requirements while on their Sea Base Adventure. All items can be signed off by the Sea Base chaplain, a chaplain aid, or an adult leader.

Requirements

Complete 1 and 2

1.	Lead the crew in two prayers (Grace before meals, prayer before leaving base for the day, prayer at the end of the day, etc.).
2.	Actively participate in two devotionals (either a Sea Base service or crew devotional). Participation requires involvement and discussion of reflection

Next: complete 2 of the following:

1.	Lead a crew devotional
2.	Make a contribution to the International Brotherhood of Scouting and have the adult leader turn the collected funds in to the Ships’ Store before you depart at the end of your adventure.
3.	Read a selection from the Bible or other religious text at the beginning of your adventure, followed by a discussion of what each participant expects from the adventure.

Once you have completed all of the requirements, please take this form to the Ship’s Store where you may purchase the Duty to God patch. You may keep the book to remind you of your time here and to aid you in the rest of your religious and Scouting journey.
